

## Book marks

These are the most simple of activities. We all know that reading with your child from a very young age is a great start for their future as confident readers. To make reading an even more attractive pastime a young children can be encouraged by creating their own book mark. You may find as your child enters the Foundation Phase in school they will make bookmarks during Forest School activities.

What you will need:

- Pieces of card cut to an appropriate size
- Decorations – this can be bits of leaves and twigs collected on a walk; glitter, sequins and all things sparkly or a collection of your child's favourite stickers
- Glue (PVA or Pritt Stick anything will do)
- Sticky backed plastic (you know the stuff you should have used to cover your school books!!)

Method:

Stick your decorations all over one side of your bookmark

Cover with sticky backed plastic

That is it, no more..... it really is that simple it doesn't need photographic instruction!!
